



## **LOFT Fellowship**

- Be a sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student attending a 4 year college or university
- Must plan to pursue a career in the fields/majors listed above
- Have a GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Be a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States with a valid Social Security Number at the time of application. All legal permanent residents must submit a copy of their valid permanent resident card or passport stamped I-551 (not expired). Individuals who need sponsorship for an immigration-related employment benefit, now or in the future, are not eligible. This includes individuals with temporary employment authorization visas, such as, E-3, F-1, H-1B, H-2, J, L-1, O-1, and TN.

Interested candidates must provide a complete application package by **April 22**<sup>nd</sup> **midnight** (see next page).

  - 1. What are your professional and personal goals?
  - 2. What are you doing to get there?
  - 3. How will you impact your community as a professional?
- iii. Why you should be considered for this Fellowship program
  - 1. What makes you a good candidate?
  - 2. What can you bring to the program?
  - 3. What is the value you see in the program for you?
- c. Letter of academic or professional recommendation.
- d. One page professional resume
